

The Newest Way to Remove Wrinkles

Beyond Botox

Botox is the best-known and most-used injectible, and with good reason: It is highly-effective when it comes to buffing out wrinkles on the upper half of the face, such as forehead lines or crow's feet.

When it comes to the lower half of the face, however, doctors prefer to use dermal fillers, which have been clinically-proven to safely and effectively fill nasolabial folds (those lines that run from your nose to the corners of your mouth). As your skin gets older, it loses its elasticity and collagen support—developments that are speeded along every time you smile, sleep on the side of your face, or simply make facial expressions. This effect is cumulative, which means by the time you enter your 30s, your face has lost volume and is beginning to sag.

Dermal fillers counteract this effect by stimulating the skin's natural collagen. As a result, the earlier you start injecting fillers into the skin, the less volume you will lose—which means your skin stays young-looking much longer.

A Real Breakthrough

For the last several years, the most commonly-used

dermal fillers have been Restylane and Juvederm, which are composed in part of hyaluronic acid, a naturally-occurring substance in the body.

Now, however, Radiesse is rapidly becoming the filler of choice. A calcium-based microsphere suspended in a water-based gel, Radiesse resembles Restylane and Juvederm in that it's made up of hypo-allergenic and biocompatible materials that are easily and safely reabsorbed into the body.

There are, however, several advantages to using Radiesse over other fillers. Not only does it stimulate your body to produce new collagen, but it also encourages collagen to grow specifically around the injection area, in a process called collagenesis. This leaves your skin always building volume—and never reverting back to what it used to look like, so long as you continue to pursue preventative wrinkle care—which explains why it is also the preferred choice for total facial contouring, such as the replumping of cheekbones, the fatpad under the eyes, mandibles and jowls.

In addition, Radiesse's results are instantaneous—and typically last up to a year, if not longer. That makes it much more cost-effective than Restylane, which typically must be re-injected every six months.
