

VIA Supports Guard Station's Mission



Since 2012, the Village Improvement Association of Doylestown (the VIA) has collaborated with the 111th Attack Wing, host unit of the Horsham Air Guard Station, to provide support for their family programs. The VIA recently presented the base with grocery and gas gift cards, for the Family Readiness Group to distribute to service members or their families. In addition, the VIA spent 5 months helping to stock the base's food pantry, checking each month to see which supplies were needed and then purchasing and delivering the items to the base. The gift cards and food pantry provide short-term assistance and help the base to determine which families need more complete support. Although the base's primary mission has changed, service members are still deploying to support war-time missions and they and their families often require additional
