Trisha Vergis was added to the gallery's roster of artists not long before COVID shut things down. A woman of determination and incredible spirit, she kept right on painting and her work began to sell through advertising, social media and our **Fine Art Fridays**. We are so pleased to now offer a great collection of Vergis paintings from over the past year.

We titled the exhibition *Deeply Rooted*, her paintings resonate with her strong ties to the people, places and history of

Bucks and Hunterdon counties. Destined to become an artist, Trisha honed her skills as a wood carver, oil painter, gallery owner and teacher. These connections are evident in everything that she paints.

She works as a direct painter. You may find Vergis alongside the Delaware or at a friend's farm working in plein air. In her studio, objects are carefully selected, arranged and lit. She sees and sketches in the droop of a sunflower, capturing nature, celebrating the beauty of imperfection. A worn farm chair, a slice of peach, flowers from a friend's garden and the occasional cat are rendered in her signature palette with a mastery of light and shadow.



Sometimes a bit of luck and timing is everything. During his 2017 spring solo exhibition in the gallery, I assisted Glenn Harrington in welcoming to his studio a busload of supporters of the Allentown Art Museum. We arranged paintings around his studio and inside his home, laid out refreshments and guided the visitors back and forth.

It was that day that I first laid eyes on his son Evan's amazing work. A very small still life caught my eye and sent chills up my spine . . . a painting that seemed as though it could have been done decades or centuries ago. (It was the way I felt upon seeing a particular Cezanne bowl of fruit at the Barnes, just blown away!) So I asked Glenn, "Do you think Evan has some pieces to show in the gallery?" The answer was yes.

Opening October 30th will be Evan's first solo exhibition at the Silverman Gallery and his first in several years.

Raised in the home of a successful artist and illustrator and then classically trained at the Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts, Evan also took classes with local artist Frank Arcuri. Since he completed his studies at PAFA he has garnered a growing and loyal group of collectors throughout the region.



Something of a Renaissance man, Evan Harrington is also a pilot and skilled carpenter, husband and father of two young children.

He works in his new home studio in Pipersville, often having several pieces around him in various stages of completion. Nothing is rushed. Evan's exacting aesthetic and calm, quiet nature are evident in paintings rich in tone and luscious detail.
