Raised in Bucks County, Dr. Daria Marley Kemp lived in Philadelphia for 10 years, where she attended medical school at Thomas Jefferson University, and completed her preliminary medicine year at Lankenau Medical Center which was followed by a dermatology residency at Thomas Jefferson University Hospital.

While at Jefferson, her research study treating Basal Cell Carcinoma received the Stelwagon Clinical Research Award in Dermatology (first prize) from the Philadelphia College of Physicians' Dermatology Section and the Everett C. Fox Memorial Award (third prize) from the American Academy of Dermatology. Her interests in dermatologic oncology and surgery were fostered by her father, Wayne Marley, M.D., and enhanced during her fellowship in Mohs Micrographic Surgery at the Dermatologic SurgiCenter in Drexel Hill. During this fully accredited American College of Mohs Surgery and ACGME fellowship program, she received advanced training in skin cancer surgery, including Mohs for melanoma, and reconstruction techniques.

Dr. Kemp takes a patient-centered approach to her practice, treating every patient with respect and taking the time to educate her patients so they can make informed decisions.

Mohs micrographic surgery has the highest success rate of all treatments for skin cancer – up to 99% – and can be performed using only local anesthesia as an in-office outpatient procedure.

We have three fellowship-trained Mohs surgeons at our practices, including Bucks County's Dr. Daria Marley Kemp. Dr. Marley Kemp has achieved the highest degree of Mohs surgery qualification by completing an American College of Mohs Surgery approved fellowship.

This state-of-the-art treatment can be performed on almost all skin cancers, including those skin cancers that are large, recurrent, or have not been effectively treated with other methods. Mohs surgery is especially used for skin cancers on the head, neck, and face, since it maximizes the cure rate yet reduces the loss of healthy skin. Dr. Marley Kemp's name may be familiar to many readers as she often worked with her father, Dr. Wayne Marley, who started the first Mohs surgery practice in Bucks County in 1985.

The Skin Cancer Foundation recommends you visit a dermatologist annually for a full-body, professional skin exam as part of an early detection strategy. If you are at higher risk of skin cancer, meaning you have fair skin, light hair, burn easily, engage in indoor tanning, have atypical moles, or have a family history of skin cancer, your doctor may recommend coming in more frequently for a skin exam.
