WORTHWHILE WEAR'S NEWEST PROGRAM, "WORTH IT" GOES VIRTUAL TO CONNECT WITH SURVIVORS ACCROSS THE COUNTRY

This January Worthwhile Wear launched a pilot of their Virtual Worth It program after having to postpone many of their in-person sessions.

Worth It, normally offered as an in-person only program, brings the tools and resources that we provide at our residential program, The Well, into a classroom setting so women who have experienced sexual exploitation can make meaningful relationships and begin healing from past trauma.



Worthwhile Wear sought a solution that would make its resources and services more readily available to women who could benefit from them.

By offering Worth It on a virtual platform, we can reach and connect with survivors from around the country.

The Worth It program is designed for women who have experienced sexual trauma from exploitation, trafficking or prostitution.

Trauma is often the primary underlying factor that causes or perpetuates many societal issues like addiction, unemployment, fractured relationships and maladaptive behaviors. We believe healing begins when trauma is identified and addressed, and when meaningful relationships are made.

Worth It staff help participants connect with area service providers, maintain sobriety, and ultimately break the cycle of exploitation. By offering this program virtually, we can meet survivors where they are at and help them on their journey to healing.
